 SWIMMING LESSONS START AGAIN NEXT WEEK Further to the letter we sent out at the start of term, swimming lessons restart next week. Please ensure that your child brings their swimming kit to school with them in the morning. Y1 & Y2 will swim on Tuesdays and Y3 & Y4 will swim on Wednesdays In order to ensure that swimming lessons are sustainable, we ask for a weekly contribution of £2 per child (or £1 for those entitled to Pupil Premium). We will add these contributions to SchoolGrid accounts on a weekly basis to make it easier to pay and reduce cash handling in school. Thanks to all parents who have already completed the swimming questionnaire we sent out—this will help us to put the appropriate support in place for the children who are not water confident or just a little worried about swimming in general. Children in Y2 are likely to be a little late in returning to school after swimming on Tuesdays—we recommend that parents aim to arrive to collect them at 3.20pm. We look forward to seeing our children make some great progress with their swimming again in the coming months. 		 It's been good to see most children return to school in full school uniform including black shoes. We appreciate that there are times when children's school shoes need replacing and parents often let us know if children may not be in shoes for a couple days. Please note though that trainers or other shoes/boots are not our agreed school uniform. Our uniform policy can be found <u>HERE</u>. We have a small number of spare uniform items should they be required - please let us know if you might be able to make use of these. EARRINGS Please note that the only type of earrings allowed in school are studs. Children must also remove these for PE/Swimming lessons. If children are unable to remove their own earrings we ask that parents remove them before school. Soft silicone earrings are acceptable as a replacement on PE days.

As this falls during the summer half term break, schools have been asked to select an additional date to ensure that all staff benefit k or	COVID TESTING AND ISOLATION Government Covid rules are changing rapidly. This week sees the removal of the need for a PCR test to confirm a positive Lateral Flow Test. Next week, the isolation period for positive cases has been reduced to as little as 5 full days. From Monday, anyone testing positive should begin isolating (Day 0). On day 5, a lateral flow test can be taken, and further tests every 24 hours. After 2 negative tests, the isolation period can end. We hope that this means many children will be able to return to school more quickly IF THEY ARE NOT INFECTIOUS. Please let us know details of when your child started symptoms or tested positive and we will be able to advise more specifically on each case.
