### COLD WEATHER, ICY PATHS!

As the cold winter weather really takes hold and the ground becomes icy we wanted to let you know how we manage this in our school grounds. Around the entrances to the school you will see 'Gritting Plans'; these show primary and secondary areas of the school grounds that we grit/salt/clear to make them as safe as possible for children, parents and staff to walk on in the mornings. In the first instance we will grit a primary area which consists of the main paths into and around school. The secondary area we grit consists mainly of the large playground which we ensure is safe to use before the children go out at playtime. Parents should note that the large playground and picnic area may still be icy as the children are brought to school. As parents are still responsible for the children until the bell rings in the morning we ask that you remind your children about the risks of icy ground and encourage them to avoid these areas. Thank you for your support.
