Spring 2 Half Term

<u>Literacy</u>

Our focus text for the beginning of the term is 'A Tale of Two Robots'. The children will be reading the story before gaining a deeper understanding of the text by picking out key vocabulary and sentences. They will then create their own science fiction story based on their own robots. I am sure we will come up with all sorts of ideas!

To conclude our topic about 'The Egyptians' the children will be writing their own newspaper report about the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb. They will be looking at the features of newspapers and applying their knowledge to report the historic event.

<u>Topic</u>

<u>Maths Makes Sense</u>

Maths is divided into 5 areas of learning. Over the next 6 weeks this is what we will be covering.

<u>Arithmetic 1</u>

Solving word problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

<u>Geometry</u>

Recognising and drawing angles including right angles. Data and Measure


Converting cm into mm and mm into cm as well money word problems eg giving change from a ± 1 .

<u>Arithmetic 2</u>

Continuing sequences of numbers and identifying the connection between the steps.

Reasoning

Solving word problems involving different units of measure.



<u>Music</u>

The children will be exploring different sequences of sound and shall be creating their own towards the end of the term. We will also be looking at musical notation and some children will begin to read different musical notes.

Religious Education

Our topic about 'Christianity' is leading us towards the Easter Story when the children will be looking at Jesus' death and his resurrection.
