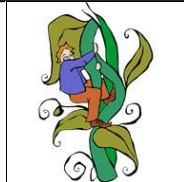
Personal Social Development

Mathematics

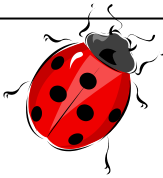

Understanding the World
