#### Personal Social Development

## Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Our indoor role play area will be transformed into a Rainforest where we will explore the environment. Our outdoor role play will become a café.

This half term in ICT the children in Turtles will be learning how to use the internet safely. They will learn about using buttons on a web browser and how to use hyperlinks to explore. We will discuss what to do if the children see anything that worries them online. You could help by exploring some simple

websites with the children such as <u>http://</u> <u>www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies</u> and

navigating between pages. We'll also learn how to copy a picture from the internet and create some jungle montages!



#### Communication, Literacy and Language Development

We spend a lot of our time on this! We will be sharing stories and looking at books. The Turtles will continue learning their tricky words and writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will be using actions to remember stories and then write them.

The Seahorses will practice mark making with paint, pens both inside and out.

Everyone will be thinking and talking about what we are doing.

## Creative Development

We will be using paint to make animal prints and some 3D models animals both large and small. We will encourage children to work both with their

friends and independently. We will be dancing to jungle rhythms and making jungle sounds.
