



<u>Literacy/Topic—St. George</u>

We will begin this half term by developing our knowledge of information texts and stories through our work on St. George. We will look at the real St. George through non-fiction texts,



developing our use of the contents page, the index page and the glossary to find information and answer questions. We will then produce our own non-fiction writing about St. George. Through the stories told about St. George we will be developing our knowledge of

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will continue our Maths learning through Maths Makes Sense:

Arithmetic: vertical addition/ subtraction with 2 and 3 digit numbers, addition/subtraction maths stories with half and guarter



Geometry: identify 2D faces on 3D shapes

Data & Measure: using a combination of coins to buy and sell objects and giving change in a shopping context **Reasoning:** finding half, quarter and three quarters of a shape and knowing that the inverse of add is take away.



Literacy/Topic: Castles

Following our work on St. George we will begin our work on Castles. We will be looking at the features of castles and exploring life in a castle, looking at the jobs people did such as the priest, the servant and the gong farmer! The children will have great fun learning how to be a good soldier and how to attack a castle. Use the following websites to find out more about castles.
