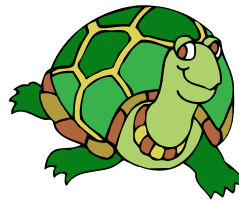


# Foundation Stage Flyer

## Physical Development

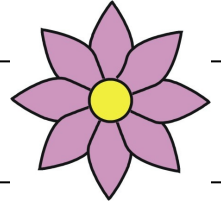

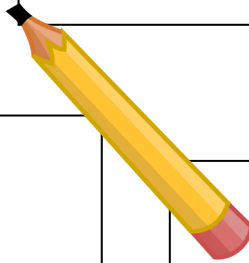
## STORY ROOM LAUNCH!
