
Topic

We will completing our work on castles this half term. We will be experiencing medieval life first hand when we explore Alnwick Castle and participate in medieval activities. We will be learning about a famous knight, St. George and finding out why he is so important to us.



Literacy

We will be developing our knowledge of information texts and stories through our work on St. George. We will look at the real St. George through non-



fiction texts, developing our use of the contents page, the index page and the glossary to find



information and answer questions. We will then produce our own non-fiction writing about St. George. Through the stories told about St. George we will be developing our knowledge of story structure and we will orally tell and write our own versions.

Numeracy

Our Numeracy work this half term will include counting objects in sets of 2 and 10. We will begin by counting pairs of socks and shoes (as long as they're not too smelly!). We will also be sharing objects into equal sets and finding half of a given number of objects.
