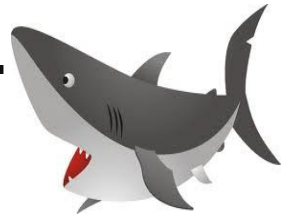

Mathematics

We will be covering lots in our daily maths sessions including:

Arithmetic: Times tables, written and mental multiplication and division. Counting on and back from a given number in steps of 3 and 4. Solving real life maths stories involving word problems and money

Data and Measure: Telling the time including quarter past and quarter to, as well as telling time using 5 minute intervals.

Geometry: Describing and sorting 2 and 3 D shapes using Venn and Carroll

Please ensure PE kits remain in school and that all children have suitable footwear for PE– This half term the Sharks will be having PE on a Thursday.

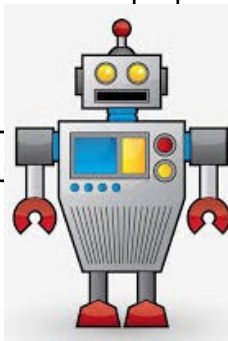
We will be continuing with our dance work thinking about speed, position and joining movements together. We are looking forward to creating Robot inspired dances.
