ANTI-BULLYING WORKSHOP

This week our Year 4 children welcomed David Burn from Be Safe to their class to lead an anti-bullying workshop. The children explored many aspects of bullying included: what kind of person a bully is, why a bully behaves the way they do, bullying issues that arise in school, cyber bullying (including bullying by text), mobile phone safety and stranger danger. These are all things that we discuss with the children in school on a regular basis and encourage children to do the same.
