SCHOOL DINNER PRICES-CONSULTATION

Due to increased costs, the governors are in the process of considering whether to raise the cost of school dinners to £2.00 per day from the beginning of September 2012. This would be a price increase of 25p per week taking the weekly cost to £10.00. At present this is only a consultation exercise and governors will consider any written responses parents may wish to make about this price increase by 12 noon on Friday 4th May 2012. Children who receive free school meals will be unaffected.
