At The Seaside

Our topic this half term is At the Seaside. We will be looking at UK seaside locations in pictures and on maps suggesting why people like to go there. We will be comparing seaside holidays in



the recent past with those taken a long time ago. We will have a role play area of a seaside shop where we will be buying and selling items for a day at the beach. We will be thinking about what we need for a day at the beach and writing instructions for packing a beach holiday suitcase then writing postcards home telling our family about our holiday. We are going to be looking at landscapes of the seaside and use natural materials from the beach to make our own sculptures





Literacy

We will be continuing with our Read, Write Inc groups.
In guided reading groups we will be thinking about punctuation in text and how it can help us read more fluently and with expression.
Children should continue to read at home and keep changing their reading books regularly to support their progression in reading and writing.

Numeracy

We will be continuing to develop our maths skills through Maths Makes Sense. In each area we will be:

Arithmetic 1:

Looking at 2 digit numbers and their value. We will be ordering these and using them in addition and subtraction maths stories and vertical calculations.

Arithmetic 2:

Looking at an embellished real-life story, saying whether it is an addition or subtract, drawing basic real-life stories from it and writing math stories.

Recognise the difference between 1D, 2D and 3D shapes and learning actions for these.

Identify 2D faces on 3D shapes, and naming them as triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons or hexagons.

Data and measure:

Giving change from ten pence and other amounts in a shopping context

Reasoning:

Cutting shapes into halves and quarters by drawing lines accurately and shading a half, a quarter and three quarters of a shape.



Year 1 Phonics

We have year 1 phonics tests this half term therefore will be doing lots of activities and games in preparation for this.

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PE

In PE this half term we will be doing games and athletics. We will hopefully be outside for this. Please ensure children have appropriate footwear in school, such as sandshoes or trainers.
