#### **Topic: Plants and Animals**

This half tem we will be learning about plants and animals that live in our local environment and be able to name some of them. We will be



learning about what plants and animals need to stay



alive and healthy and how they grow and change. We will learn that plants produce seeds which grow into new plants and we will investigate what they need to grow and record our observations.

### <u>Maths</u>

We will begin this half term by counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will use a number square to help us continue number patterns. We will also continue our Maths learning through Maths Makes Sense:



**Arithmetic:** vertical addition/subtraction with 2 and 3 digit numbers, addition/subtraction maths stories with half and quarter

Geometry: identify 2D faces on 3D shapes

**Data & Measure:** measuring volume in mls; using a combination of coins to buy and sell objects

**Reasoning:** finding half, quarter and three quarters of a shape

#### <u>Literacy: Traditional Tales</u>

In our literacy work this half term we will be looking at a variety of traditional tales. We will be learning about setting, characters, vocabulary and the structure of the stories. We will begin by exploring the story 'Beauty and the Beast'. You can support your child with this work by sharing a variety of traditional tales at home.
