Literacy

This half term we will be exploring family relationships and charcters' feelings through the stories Cottonwool Colin by Jeanne Willis and Sister for Sale by Adrian Bradbury. We will be learning about the features of explanation texts and use our knowledge to write and explanation of a frog's life cycle.

Maths

Number: we will be comparing and ordering numbers up to 100 and recognising the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number. We will be learning to recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 and use this knowledge to help solve problems. We will solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division.

Data, measure and statistics: we will compare and order lengths and use appropriate units to measure lengths and heights. We will collect information about our class and use tally charts, pictograms, block diagrams and simple tables to show our results.

Geometry: we will identify and describe properties of 2D and 3D shapes including sides and edges.

Science

We will begin this half Term by learning about ourselves, including how we grow and change and the importance of exercise and a healthy diet. We will then be looking at other animals and what they need to stay alive. Our work will include learning about life cycles and habitats. Andy Warhol to develop ideas to create our own self portraits. We will look at how artists use straight/wavy lines, shading and colour to



create their portraits. We will be observing ourselves closely using mirrors and photographs to add detail to our work.
