Topic

Our topic this half term is 'Plants and Animals'. We will be comparing animals in different environments. We will be looking at the parts of a plant and learning about how plants grow.

<u>Literacy</u>

The texts we will be using in Literacy this half term are linked to our topic work. We will be reading 'The Emperor's Egg' by Martin Jenkins, 'Giraffe's can't dance' by Giles Andreae and Jack and the Beanstalk.

We will be continuing to work hard daily with our reading and phonics.

Numeracy

In Numeracy this half term we will be looking at 2-digit numbers. We will be learning about tens & units, introducing numbers to 100 and becoming familiar with the 100sq.

Your child will continue to come home with a homework book which will contain a few different choices for them to complete. Pupils do not need to complete everything on the list. They can choose the activities they would like to do. Homework will be set every Monday and pupils will be given a chance throughout the week to share work they have completed at

home. Please encourage and support your child to complete their homework.

This half term the children will be exploring sound and music in ICT. We'll be recording and changing voices, finding and adding music and sound effects and creating our own music using the computers. At home the children could find and download sound effects from the internet using

In school we'll start to develop mini podcasts combining voice, music and sound effects.
