Topic Work

In our topic, we will continue to learn about the Ancient Egyptians but this time the focus is on Art and Design and Design and Technology.

Art and Design

We will look at detail how Ancient Egyptian artists drew people and use this knowledge to create own picture of an Egyptian. We will then use a cracked wax effect to recreate pictures that were drawn on the walls in tombs.

<u>M</u>aths

Children are reciting their times tables really well now. The next step is to be able to recall any times table fact at a rapid pace. Remember; learn the tables up to 12x12! Use this website for a variety of multiplication games:

The aspects of mathematics taught this half term are: <u>Arithmetic 1</u>: Vertical additions and subtractions with tricky columns and using a grid for long division. <u>Geometry:</u> Using four quadrants to draw circles and polygons

<u>Data and Measure:</u> Calculating the mean

<u>Arithmetic 2</u>: Solving two-step word problems and solving word problems with decimals

<u>Reasoning:</u> Calculating a product of two numbers with decimals

<u>Literacy</u>

Our focus for fiction this half term is all about facing dilemmas: a difficult choice that someone has to make. The children will read the text 'Lost or Stolen?' by Narinder Dhami and then use this to write a new chapter for 'Lost or Stolen'.

Our non-fiction work will have the children looking at information texts presented in different ways. They will then create and present their own information texts. The children will also plan a presentation to pitch a new gadget to potential investors!

Science:

Light and Dark is the topic for this half term.

The children will observe the apparent movement of the sun and the associated changes in shadows. Their investigatory work will see the children recording measurements and observations and drawing conclusions.
