

SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR POLICY REMINDER

Our full school behaviour policy is available on the school website but thought it would be valuable to remind parents of how we deal with behaviour issues in school. For minor issues (such as shouting out, chatting) we have a 'Step' system that involves reminding children of expectations, moving children away from friends, moving to another class for a short period and eventually being sent to Mr Heeley.

Children rarely move far up the steps. For more serious behaviours that we consider unacceptable at Amble Links (hitting/kicking others or damaging property, swearing, bullying, stealing or refusing to do as an adult asks) we have a yellow/red card system. Based on the individual circumstances of the incident, a child who had done any of these things will be sent to Mr Heeley or Miss Lightley and receive a yellow card (this is formally logged). We do not tell parents about this 1st yellow card and it acts as a warning for the child. If, within the same half term, a child receives another yellow card we immediately call parents in and explain the reasons for the yellow card during the half term they will be formally excluded from school for a week of lunchtimes; it is extremely rare for this to happen. At the end of a half term the children rip up any yellow cards and have a fresh start. This

system has worked very well for us for a number of years now and hopefully parents see this reflected in the overall behaviour of our pupils.

PARENTS' EVENINGS

Parents are reminded to book an appointment for Parents Evenings to be held on Tuesday and Wednesday after school. These appointments will give you a chance to chat with your child's new teacher, find out about how your child has settled into the class and learn more about class routines and expectations as well as ways that you can help your child.
