Maths Makes Sense

Arithmetic 1: + and - negative numbers, x two 2 digit numbers and ÷ 3digit by 1digit

Geometry: Use a protractor to measure acute and obtuse angles

Data and Measure: Use ratio to convert different units of measure

Arithmetic 2: Solving word problems

Reasoning: Algebraic expressions using the symbols x and y

Music: Clarinets

The children will continue to be taught to play the clarinet by an external teacher: Mrs Nicklen.

Science: Rocks and Soils

Rocks and Soils will continue to be taught this half term. The children will experiment with different types of soil and measure time it takes for water to flow through them.

As well as all the sporting events listed above, the children will continue developing their skills in net, court and wall games.

RE: Sikhism

The children will gain knowledge of the main features of a Sikh place of worship.
