Mathematics

This half term we will be completing our science based topic Funnybones.

We will be investigating skeletons and looking closely at bones, joints and muscles and comparing them with animal skeletons.

We will exploring the effects of exercise on our bodies and recording what we find out.

There are lots of great activities linked to the human body for you to try on Purple Mash— the children have loved this topic so far!

From Source to Sea

Our main topic this half term will have a strong Geography focus. We will be thinking about contrasting locations, we will firstly be looking at the locality that we live in and comparing this to another seaside location in a different part of the world. We will use a range of media including maps, photographs and the Internet as well as collecting their own evidence to compare location, weather, population, transport links, tourism and physical features. In our Literacy work we will be becoming travel agents and tour guides and



creating holiday guides which will persuade people to visit Amble. You can help by collecting any local leaflets and photographs as well as visiting any local landmarks!
