Topic Work/Literacy

During the autumn term we will be learning about Romans. This is an extensive subject so we will be focussing our learning specifically on Roman soldiers in Britain.

Each child will become a Roman soldier and discover what life was like living away from home, the life-long commitment to the army and how training was *not* for the faint-hearted!!

Will they be able to handle the centurions constantly barking instructions at them? And how will they cope when faced with the cold opposition of the Celts?

Their joys and fears of being a soldier will be captured in their diary entries and everything you need to know about a Roman soldier will be displayed in information texts produced by the children.

The children will hear stories about Romans and create their own using all the knowledge they have learnt over

term.
