### BOOKING HOLIDAYS

Parents are reminded that we will not authorise holidays during term time due to the negative impact that absences from school have on children's learning. We will apply for penalty notices if attendance in the 12 months leading up to the holiday has been less than 93%. During May and June, children in Y1 and Y2 complete Phonics and SATs tests which are reported nationally and also used as a measure of school performance. Results of assessments are also used to measure children's progress when they reach Year 6.
