ADDITIONAL NURSERY TIME OPPORTUNITY

Parents may be aware that some nursery children are entitled to an additional free 15 hours per week of childcare, meaning that they are entitled to a total of 30 hours of nursery provision with us. A number of parents take up this entitlement and we have a small group of children who stay in nursery throughout the day. At present we have the capacity to keep any of our other nursery children for afternoon sessions for a fee of £15 per session. This additional time represents very good value for money as sessions continue to be led by a teacher and teaching assistants. If you are interested in taking up these sessions on a regular or one-off basis please call into the school office or speak to any of our Early Years staff who will be happy to help. Payments can be made in cash or through the Live Kitchen system.

SWIMMING NEXT WEEK

Swimming lessons for next week are for Year 1 on Thursday and Year 3 on Friday. Please ensure children come to school with their swimming kit. We ask for a contribution of £4 per lesson (children have 1hr lessons every other week) or £2 if your child is entitled to Pupil Premium.
