PTA MOVIE NIGHT



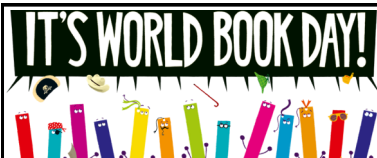
