Mathematics

The children will continue to cover different aspects of mathematics. These include:

Arithmetic: The children will continue to use all operations to solve word problems. They will round numbers with one decimal place to the nearest whole number and compare decimal numbers also.

Data and Measure: Converting between different units of measure and use this to solve word problems.

Geometry: The children will be taught about describing movements between positions by using the correct mathematical vocabulary.

There will more focus on comparing and classifying geometric shapes based on their properties such as identifying acute and obtuse angles.

Languages: French

Ancient Egypt: Tomb Raiders



Literacy:

The children will research the discovery of Tutankhamen and uncover hidden treasures. They will use this information to write their own report—detailing many facts about the discovery.

The will also explore fiction - stories set in Ancient Egypt, again, linked to the burial of King Tutankhamen.

Art and Design:

Wall paintings were used in Ancient Egypt to decorate the walls in tombs and pyramids.

The children will learn the techniques used in the past to draw Egyptian people and use these techniques to create their own masterpiece! They will combine pencil work, crayons and paint to create a 'cracked wall' effect tomb painting.

History:

Artefacts will be used for the children to enquire about the past. They will ask questions and explore the answers.

Within these topic lessons, the children will be exploring mummification, burial sites, hieroglyphics, Gods and Goddesses and the afterlife.
