




As part of our topic 'This is Me!' we will be collecting and organising information about ourselves such as eye/hair colour. As an introduction to data handling have a go at Animal Island data on

## Literacy

Your child will be taught Literacy in a small focused group with pupils of a similar ability using the structured programme Read Write Inc. These sessions will include daily phonics which they will then apply in their reading and writing tasks. Fred Frog is a key character who will support our learning. Ask your child how we use 'Fred Talk' to help us with our independent reading and writing. If you wish to know any more about this programme feel free to come and speak to us.



Your child will continue to develop their literacy skills through our topic work; composing and orally rehearsing complete sentences then extending our sentences to make our writing interesting. You can help your child develop these skills during everyday conversation by extending sentences e.g. Look at that bus can be made more interesting by extending it to Look at that big red shiny bus.
