#### SCHOOL PHOTOS

Unfortunately, we have had to cancel the usual individual and family photos that we had planned in for next month. The practicalities of doing this safely would have meant that only individual photographs could have been taken and that there would have been much movement of children around the school; something that we are trying to avoid as much as possible. Hopefully we'll be able to consider this again later in the school year.



#### HOMEWORK ON GOOGLE CLASSROOM

We will soon be finalising details about how we will provide remote learning in the event of individuals or a whole class needing to self-isolate.

We expect that our offer will be very similar to the one we provided during lockdown. This week we asked parents to complete a short survey to let us know what kind of devices

children have access to in their homes on which they can complete online learning. This information will

help us direct support more appropriately.

From next week, teachers in Y2, Y3 and Y4 will be sending out homework through Google Classroom, which all of the children should know how to access through School360. We will also send homework out by email to parents. Much of the homework set can still completed in the children's books but feedback from parents about completed tasks will be able to be completed online. We are doing this to ensure that the children are very familiar with Google Classroom for if they are required to complete daily work through this means if they

are isolating. Y1 homework will initially be delivered by email.

## COVID-19 UPDATE

In light of the new restrictions placed on the North East last week we quickly relaunched our after school clubs in order to help parents avoid the need for household mixing wherever possible. The after school club runs until 5.15pm

after school every evening on a paid basis costing (per child) £2.50 until 4.15pm, £3.50 until 4.45pm and £5.00 until 5.15pm. This represents excellent value . Over the next few weeks we'll monitor the viability of this

provision based on how well it is used. Along with this week's newsletter , we have also sent you copies of an NHS document, 'Covid-19: A quick guide for parents' that you may find useful as well as a letter to parents from Public Health England about using the Test

# and Trace system. Please take the time to read these documents

This week, we have spoken with all of the children again about appropriate social distancing wherever possible. Although they are working closely together in their own class 'bubbles' they do not mix with other children in the school during the school day and are continuously

reminded that they should not be playing games that involve touching one another. We've also asked the children to be really mindful about keeping appropriate distance from friends and other adults as they are dropped off and collected. We ask that parents also model and encourage the same behaviours..

This week we've been really impressed with the high levels of attendance we've had in school, we hope this continues for many weeks and months to come as it'll make a big difference for children catching up.
