Mathematics

We will be covering lots in our daily maths sessions including:

Arithmetic: Place Value, finding 1, 10, 100 more and less than, doubling and halving, Fractions, multiplication and division.

<u>Data and Measure:</u> Measuring length/height using standard measures such as cm, m, and solving problems linked to money and measure.

Geometry: 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Please continue to access Mathletics each week to complete set tasks and also earn points and certificates

Later we will be learning about and investigating The Stone Age and thinking about how life would be different living at this time. We will be making tools and investigating any signs of the Stone Age which still exist now such as Stonehenge.
