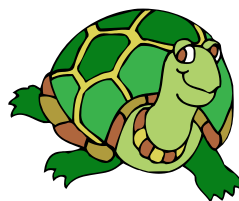


Foundation Stage Flyer



Understanding the World

Physical Development

Mathematics

This half term we will be counting in 2s and 10s practically. We will also be using our addition and subtraction facts to help us solve word problems. We will also be weighing objects to sort from the heaviest to the lightest and using water to measure capacity.

Literacy

For the last 6 weeks we will be continuing with our Read Write Inc on a daily basis. The RWI groups have been changed as we are still making lots of progress. We will be using our RWI skills to write lots of stories exploring different characters and settings including Dear Zoo and Noah's Ark. Keep checking for the weekly challenge in the writing area too!

In preparation for Year 1 we will be learning to line up ready to come into our class in the morning. From Monday we will line up at the door nearest Year 1 to come in. We will leave from this door at home time too.
