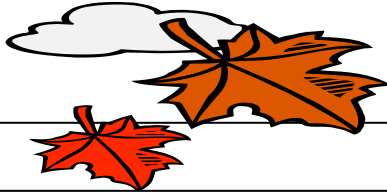


# Foundation Stage Flyer

- Share some nursery rhymes such as Hickory Dickory Dock, Humpty Dumpty
- Counting songs such as 'There were 10 in the Bed' are an excellent way for children to practise their counting up to 10.
- Encourage your child to become more independent by helping them practise to put on their own coats, and shoes
