




Topic Work - Spring Forward

Literacy


As well as in Read, Write inc lessons we will be doing extra phonics sessions throughout the day to consolidate all of the sounds children have been learning.

Through topic we will be using information texts to find out about dinosaurs.

We will be using dictionaries in guided reading sessions to look up the meanings of different words linked to our topics.

We will be concentrating on using the punctuation marks in our books to help us read with expression and how this supports us to become fluent readers.
