OUR SCHOOL ONE WAY SYSTEM

Following Covid we decided to keep the one way system for drop-off and pick-up at the start and end of the school day. This decision was based on feedback from parents and our own observations. The one way system has made the start and end of the school day run much more smoothly and safely; children come into school

more calmly and with less fuss. At the end of each day we are much more easily able to pair children up with adults that are collecting them.

Unfortunately, there are an increasing number of adults collecting children who are not following the system despite our continued requests.

We ask again that parents and other adults collecting children set a good example to the children by following the one way system. We appreciate that this system may add a couple more minutes onto your journey but think that this is a small sacrifice to pay for the safety and smooth running of the school. Should you need to visit the school office, please do so BEFORE PICKING UP OR DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD.

BECOMING AMBLE LINKS PRIMARY SCHOOL!

Yesterday, [Northumberland County Council's Cabinet approved the implementation of the proposals to reorganise schools in the Coquet Partnership to a two-tier \(Primary/](#)

Secondary) system. This means that we will become Amble Links Primary School in September 2024. At this time, our current Year 3 children will stay with us here and become our first Year 5 children and then become our first Year 6 children in September 2025. There will be some building work involved to make this happen. We'll provide more information as things progress.
