SWIMMING UPDATE

Having recently reviewed our curriculum timetabling and budget, governors have made the decision this week that we will not now be starting swimming lessons for children in Reception after Easter as we have in previous years. Children at Amble Links will now begin their swimming lessons in Year 1. It is also likely that children in other year groups will not swim every single half term of the year from September. Due to our location, we are still committed to providing many more swimming lessons than most first/primary schools currently provide and that all of our children will be able to swim 25m by the time they leave Year 6. This has not been an easy decision, but we feel it is necessary at this time.

YEAR 4 SKIPPING FESTIVAL

This week our Year 4 children enjoyed joining in with other schools from the local area to take part in a Skipping Festival at Ashington Leisure Centre. They practised skipping techniques and worked with partners and in groups to skip in a variety of different ways. MILK ORDERS

We notice that a lot of children do not drink their milk on a regular basis. To avoid waste could you please check that your child definitely wants milk every day before you order.
