Literacy

We will be continuing to teach reading and writing in small groups through the Read, Write, Inc programme.

Some of our Y2 pupils will be beginning literacy lessons. We will begin by using non-fiction texts to find out about Puffins and writing our own short factual accounts. We will then be looking at stories with familiar settings. We will be identifying the main character and setting in a story and re-enacting stories, sequencing the main events and using phrases from the texts.
