FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND PUPIL PREMIUM—PLEASE CHECK AND APPLY

The Pupil Premium is extra funding that school can access for children who are entitled to Free School meals. This additional funding helps us keep high levels of support staff and also allows us to provide services such as our own school nurse. Unfortunately, children do not automatically qualify for benefits related free school meals and many parents do not know that they still need to apply for these as many of our younger children already receive a free meal as part of the government's Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.
