



OLYMPIC TORCH IN AMBLE

The Olympic Torch is due to come through Amble early on Friday 15th June. This is a once in a lifetime event and we hope that all of our staff and children are able to see the torch.

The middle school is having a 'pre-activation entertainment' between 7.15am and 7.45am and have invited all the local children to attend with parents before the torch relay passes through. They plan to then move people over to Albert Street to see the convoy of sponsors and the relay come through at about 7.50am.
