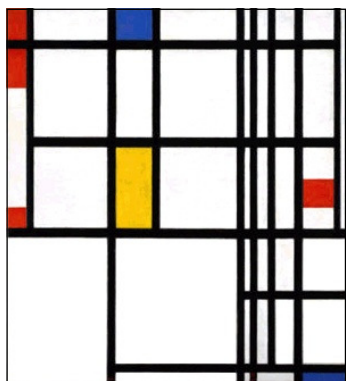




### Works of Art

It's our PTA disco next Tuesday! Look out for the posters around school for more information. We look forward to seeing you there!

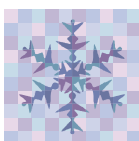
