Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables, including recognising odd and even numbers

Calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (x), division (÷) and equals (=) signs

Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods and multiplication and division facts, including problems in context

Show that the multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot

Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables

Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting categories by quantity

Ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data

Geometry: Properties of Shape

Identify and describe the properties of 2D shapes, including the number of sides and line symmetry in a vertical line

Compare and sort 2D shapes

Identify and describe the properties of 3D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces

Compare and sort 3D shapes and everyday objects
