As we decided to give this reward at very late stage of the year we have lowered the percentage we originally mentioned slightly. **Next year the end of year attendance reward will be more challenging; to earn the reward at the end of the year children from Reception to Y4 will need to achieve 100% attendance in 4 out of the 6 half terms AND be late to school no more than 15 times in the whole school year AND have no more than 5% of the school year missed through holidays.**
