FREE BREAKFAST CLUB BEGINNING AFTER EASTER!

We're delighted to announce that, after Easter, we will be offering a daily free Breakfast Club to all children in Reception to Y5. This is because we are an 'early adopter' of the government's Free Breakfast Club programme. The free aspect of Breakfast Club will run from 8am until the start of school each day (children will not be admitted after 8.15am as this doesn't leave enough time for breakfast). We will also be offering an earlier start of 7.30am. There will be a daily charge of £1.50 per day for children coming to Breakfast Club before 8am—this will be charged to parents' Arbor accounts. Children attending Breakfast Club are provided with cereal, toast and a drink and there may also be days when there are some different choices! After the children have had breakfast they are welcome to play with friends until the start of the school day. Coming to Breakfast Club means that the children will never be late for school and ensures a calm start to the day. At present, there is no need for children to be booked into Breakfast Club each day so it's just a case of bringing children to the main school doors.


