



PE DAYS—SOME CHANGES

At the start of this term it has been necessary to make some slight changes to our PE timetable. The changes affect Year 2 and Reception. On PE days, children should come to school in their top half school uniform and bottom half PE kit (trainers/leggings/joggers/shorts). There are still a number of children each week who are not being sent to school in PE kits meaning staff need to spend extra time finding spare clothing and footwear to ensure that the children can take part safely in PE lessons.

Parents should also ensure that children do not come to school on PE days wearing earrings if they are unable to take them out themselves.

Our PE days are now as follows:

Mondays: Y5 and Y2

Tuesdays: Reception and Nursery

Wednesdays: Y3 and Year 4

Fridays: Year 1
