ATTENDANCE LETTERS

In line with our attendance policy, the Education Welfare Officer has visited school today to review attendance and we will shortly be sending letters to parents of pupils who's attendance is below 92%. There have been a few bugs going around recently with quite a number of children absent from school. In the earlier part of the year, this can have quite an effect on overall attendance figures. Our attendance procedure may well trigger initial attendance letters (Letter 1) but is reviewed on a 3 weekly cycle meaning that further letters will only be sent should more absences occur. A period of good attendance will always improve overall percentages and it is improvement that we look for when reviewing cases. Looking at our patterns of absence, it is quite unusual for children to be absent from school with illness for any more than 2 or 3 separate times in a school year. We would usually recommend seeking advice from Jane, our school nurse, if this is the case.

SPELLING SHED

To help support children to practise and learn their weekly spellings in a fun and engaging way, we have now signed up all of our Y1 and Y2 children to Spelling Shed. Spelling Shed is a game-based tool that can be used at home to boost children's confidence in spelling. It has already proven to be successful with our KS2 pupils who enjoy playing games and practising their weekly spellings in a fun and interactive way.
