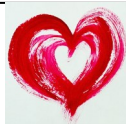

On Friday 13th February, the day before Valentines Day, we are holding a 'wear what you love' non uniform day. For a £1 donation towards school fundraising children can wear their favourite clothes to school. We will also be selling a variety of Valentines themed sweets and cakes at breaktime (we would recommend that children bring another £1 if they would like to buy something). Children should still wear sensible shoes and have a warm coat for outdoors.

YEAR 1 & 3 SWIMMING

Swimming lessons for children in Y1 and Y3 start on the first Tuesday back after the half term break. A separate email has been sent to parents of children in these year groups and it is important that parents of Y1 children respond to the short questionnaire that will help us support the children better during their swimming lessons. Parents are also asked to ensure that children are able to dress themselves after swimming lessons and to support the children to practise this.

CHILDREN USING SOCIAL MEDIA

Again this week, we have been asked to investigate and intervene in issues related to children using social media. As children are not allowed to use mobile phones/social media in school these issues are very obviously from social media use at home. Most social media platforms have a minimum age limit of 13 so it is important that parents take responsibility for what their children are doing online and appreciate that children of primary school age do not always have the emotional maturity to be using social media safely or appropriately. These incidents take up valuable staff time that could be better used supporting children's learning.

KS2 PARENTS TO CLASSROOMS AFTER ASSEMBLY NEXT FRIDAY

Next Friday (13th February), parents of children in Years 3-6 are invited to go back to classrooms with the children to look through their work with them. This is always a very busy time in school so parents are asked to be patient in getting to classrooms after assembly. There is plenty of time to be with the children!
