## MOBILE PHONES AND SMART DEVICES

Following recent government guidance we have strengthened our mobile phone policy to ensure that children do not have access to mobile phones during the school day. Currently, only Y5 and Y6 children are allowed to bring phones to school and these must be turned off and away on bags or pockets as soon as they are on the school site. These are then handed to staff as children come into school and are only returned at the end of the school day. This policy also extends to other smart devices such as smart watches that are able to connect to the internet and have the ability to send messages, take photographs or record audio or video.

**PLEASE ENSURE THAT CHILDREN DO NOT WEAR SMART WATCHES TO SCHOOL.** These are a distraction and a safety risk.

## FIDGETS & TOYS FROM HOME

We have noticed a huge increase in the number of 'fidget toys' and other toys that are being brought in from home. In many cases these are causing more distraction to the children and also leading to conflict. Following recent staff training on sensory needs, we have invested in a number of sensory/movement resources to support children who we deem to need these and will provide these from school ensuring that we have made reasonable adjustments for the children that need them without causing distraction to others. Moving forward, the use of fidgets will be in agreement with your child's class teacher who is best placed to assess what works best for you child in school. Please do not allow your child to bring toys in from home unless this is specifically agreed

## EY/KS1 PARENTS TO CLASSROOMS

Next Friday (6th February), parents of children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are invited to go back to classrooms with the children to look through their work with them and 'stay and play' in nursery. This is always a very busy time in school so parents are asked to be patient in getting to classrooms after assembly. There is plenty of time to be with the children!
