Other than our daily after school club, all after school clubs have now finished for this year. The last after school club will be on Thursday 16th July.

PICNIC AND PEA HUNT

Our Family Picnic and Pea Hunt will be taking place on Thursday 16th July. The picnic will take place in the picnic area/quiet garden at 12.00 noon. **Family members are welcome to come and join us but please do not bring children along who should be attending their own schools on that day.** All visitors should enter the picnic area through the Early Years gate. We have sent out an online form by email to complete to let us know whether parents wish to bring a packed lunch for their child or have one provided by school. **THERE WILL BE NO AFTERNOON NURSERY SESSION (INCLUDING 30 HOURS PROVISION) ALTHOUGH PARENTS ARE WELCOME TO BRING THE CHILDREN ALONG TO THE PICNIC AND PEA HUNT.** After the Pea Hunt children will return to their classrooms and be dismissed from their usual doors. Please be patient at collection time as we have lots of children to safely pair up with parents. If the weather is poor we may need to call off the picnic as we will not be able to safely accommodate everybody indoors. We may also need to cancel the Pea Hunt.

AS OUR QUIET GARDEN IS LIKELY TO BE VERY BUSY, WE ASK THAT CHILDREN STAY WITH THEIR PARENTS AND ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RUN AROUND. WE WILL POST ANY CHANGES ON OUR FACEBOOK PAGE AND BY EMAIL TO PARENTS - PLEASE DO NOT RING SCHOOL.

LIBRARY BOOKS

We still have a number of school library books outstanding for this year. Replacing books can be a big pressure on school budget. Please look carefully at home and return any books to school as soon as possible so that other children can benefit from these in the future.

SCHOOL UNIFORM AND EAR PIERCING

In preparation for next year, we ask that parents carefully consider when children get their ears pierced. Children must be able to remove their earrings to be able to take part fully in PE lessons and after school sports clubs.
