AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

We continue to run our daily after school club, providing childcare for children from Reception to Y6 after school. This provision usually runs from 3.15pm until 5.15pm but can run until 6pm when booked in advance. The children attending After School Club are free to take part in a range of activities that are on offer. Daily costs are £3.50 (until 4.15pm), £4.50 (until 4.45pm), £6.00 (until 5.15pm) and £8.00 (until 6pm). Payments are made through the Arbor app. Call or email the school office to book in.
